TREASURER'S REPORT (for 2024) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 10th March 2025

Dear SSOS Members

2024 has been a busy year with regular attendances at our Monthly Meetings and new members to swell our ranks.

Throughout 2024, your committee has kept a watchful eye on the accounts (with a degree of nagging from me) and although we incurred a loss of \$450 this was a definite improvement on the previous year's \$4000. I believe that if we had been able to hold our Spring Show, we might not have had a loss at all.

Our major expenses are prizes and prize money to our members of about \$1400, The sponsorship from Bunnings helps here as did returning the show prize money to 2022 levels. Show expenses of \$1000 and Hall rental \$1092. This is as it should be, money benefitting our members.

Our Monthly plant raffles and Show raffles are still our major income source and I am grateful that our members continue to support these - \$3300. I know that raffle tickets are purchased in hopes of winning a prize but I'm also aware that folk see it as a way of supporting our Society so thank you.

Our Sales Bench revenue from our meetings and the Winter show was \$1600. Thank you to those who sell through our Sales Bench and help our members add to their collections.

We have already received about \$1000 in memberships and should add to this as the year proceeds. This should add an additional \$300 to our accounts. New members now pay for their badge which represents \$189 the club didn't have to expend in 2024.

I'd like to thank Jan Robinson for her assistance in putting the Annual Report together and for her encouraging support and advice, Di Philips and Robert Nicol for manning the Sales Bench each month and Robert Cawley our ever-reliable raffle ticket seller.

As I'm stepping down as Treasurer, I'd like to thank the members and Committee for their cooperation through these last 5 years and wish SSOS well in the future

PRESIDENTS' REPORT (for 2024) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 10th March 2025

Dear SSOS Members

I'd like to start by giving you an overview of our activities for the past year.

Fourteen people have joined the Society, eleven haven't renewed their membership and we lost two life members, being Bob Moar and Audrey Marks. To date our membership stands at 85 which includes 6 life members.

Our guest speakers for the year were Melissa Karayannis, Gary Hodder, Wal Chapman, Daniel Coulton, Peter D'Olier (2), Christoff Mans, Jan Robinson, David Brooks and we held our Auction in May.

We held three growers group meetings, two at David Hicks' house and one at Rhonda Jackson's house.

We held three Bunnings information sessions for the public where we repotted plants and provided advice on orchid culture, and manned a table at the Bunnings Mother's Day promotion in May.

In November, Committee members presented a talk on orchid culture at Caringbah Garden Club, and in September we participated in the Bushcare promotional event in Parc Menai by having an information stall.

Our Winter show was held in June with 97 plants displayed. We were happy to make a small profit. Unfortunately, our Spring show was cancelled due to refurbishment works at Woolooware Shores and the lack of a suitable alternative venue due to the Election.

In terms of our monthly meetings, the total number of plants benched was 737. October had the highest plants benched with 86 plants and June was the lowest with 50. The class with the most plants benched was Class 9, Miscellaneous Hybrids with 88 plants.

We are proud to have three members undertaking the OSNSW Judging Course. They are Melissa Karayannis, John Ng and Mark Drury.

Our Society doesn't function without a dedicated committee and membership. I'd like to thank the committee for all their wonderful efforts over the past year. They all supported the society by working behind the scenes and attending the external activities we participated in and assisted where required.

I'd like to thank Diane Phillips and Sylvia Fitch who have decided not to renominate for the committee. Diane commenced on the committee in 2022 and has willingly assisted on the sales table and prepared supper when needed. Sylvia came on last year. They always provided assistance when able and were great committee members.

I would like to thank Margaret Spring, who has been on the committee since 2017 and has decided to leave the committee and have a worthwhile rest. She took on the role of Treasurer in 2022. Margaret has been a reliable and dependable Treasurer and conscientiously managed our finances and had many struggles with the Commonwealth Bank.

We cannot forget our past President, Frank Daniel who joined the committee in 2010. He was President from 2014 to 2017 and was Vice President from 2018 to 2020, and since that time has remained on the committee. Frank is also leaving the committee. Frank has been dependable and a valuable committee member and source of sound advice and leadership, especially to myself. His contribution to the Society was recognised when he was awarded life membership in 2023.

I like to thank David Hicks who is stepping down as Secretary but will stay on the committee. David commenced on the committee in 2020 when he took on the Secretary's role and has been Bulletin Editor since May 2022. He has been a reliable and efficient Secretary and has been a great support for me.

I'd like to thank committee members Melissa Karayannis, who manages our Facebook and Instagram sites, Jenny Sharpham who organises our supper, and Mark Drury and Paul Sheaffe for their contribution and support to the Society. I'm pleased that they are all continuing on the committee.

We have been very fortunate to have such a committed and enthusiastic committee. Their contribution is greatly appreciated, and Frank's and Margaret's knowledge and experience will be missed.

I cannot forget the wonderful membership we have. To all of you who willingly support our activities and contribute at our meetings when you set up the room and put it back to order after the meetings, man the sales table, sell and buy sale plants, judge at our meetings and generally make the meetings a fun, friendly and happy place to be.

Speaker at our March Meeting

Richie Dimon - Orchids Encountered on a Trip to Borneo and Peninsula Malaysia



Our last meeting was one of those rare opportunities for us to see orchids thriving in their wild natural habitat. Richie has travelled into some of the most rugged, inhospitable and challenging terrain in the world, where these beautiful orchids have, and continue to thrive in their unique conditions.
