

# Presentation from the August Meeting John Costa - Orchid Re-Potting





Last meeting our guest speaker was John Costa who spoke to us on his methods of re-potting. For the demonstration, John had pre prepared a number of cymbidium divisions. Prior to potting up, these had been soaked for approx 1 hour with Auxinone® to promote root growth.

John advised that he generally tries to use the same mix for all his orchids, being a dry course bark (in this case, Van Schaiks Bio Gro) around 12 - 15mm, course perlite and sometimes charcoal with approx 60% bark and the others in roughly equal parts. At times he said he often just uses the bark for certain orchids.

John spoke of the importance of not 'overpotting' in reference to the size of the pot in relation to the division, and not burying the bulbs too low in the mix. Also ensuring the mix is 'tapped down' to secure the plant around the roots, plus the occasional use of foam pieces between the plant and the pot edge, to steady the plant while the roots develop. (A good tip!!)

He also promoted the inclusion of some fertilizer like Strike-Back or Osmocote in the process of filling the pot about halfway. On completion, the plants looked great, and John kindly donated the repotted divisions to our monthly raffle.

Thank-you John for sharing your many years of knowledge and experience (and tips) with us on this important topic.

President Rhonda extended a warm welcome to everyone, and opened the general meeting at 8:00pm.

**MINUTES:** *Robert Nicol* motioned that the July minutes were an accurate record. Seconded by *Pam Davies*. Carried.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

**CHANGES TO ON-LINE BANKING:** Rhonda, Mike, Mark and Melissa, the four account signatories, attended Westpac Menai to finalise the opening of the new account. Three accounts were opened and two key-cards requested. Mike and Melissa will hold the key-cards. Mike, Melissa and Mark have Administrator access to add and remove authorised operators of the account.

The purposes of the accounts are:

- A Community Solutions One account for our main operational account with \$4,400.
- A Community Solutions One debit account to be attached to the key-cards. Money to be transferred as required.
- A Term deposit of \$10,000 for 3 months @ 3.76%

\$14,493 was in the CBA cheque account. A bank cheque costing \$30 was drawn for \$14,400 to be paid into the Westpac accounts, leaving \$93 – less \$30, equalling \$63.

With this new account we can perform on-line transfers so this should speed up payments to you.

**POINT OF SALE EFTPOS TERMINAL**: four options were put forward for consideration of the committee. The committee has decided to purchase a Commonwealth Bank Square Mini at \$59 and transaction cost of 1.1%. This will be linked to our new Westpac account.

The committee agreed to purchase a CommBank Square Mini as it was the cheapest, had the lowest transaction costs and provided a physical terminal. We can set it up so that the transaction costs are charged to the customer. We hope to use it at the Spring Show.

Rhonda contacted the bank to organise it.

ATO NOT-FOR-PROFIT TAX RETURN 2024-2025: Mike and Rhonda lodged this return today.

**Re-Potting:** Rhonda thanked **George Birss** for the donation of a range of pots, a pen and butterfly clips for the repotting at the show.

**Show Schedule:** Some amendments have been made and they will be explained at the September meeting. David will send the show documents out at the end of August.

**VACANCIES ON THE COMMITTEE 2026**: Rhonda and David Hicks are stepping down from the committee in March 2026. A President and Secretary will need to be elected. In our society the role of Public Officer normally stands with the Secretary, and Show Secretary's role needs to be filled as well.

**ATTENDANCE RECORD FOR MEETINGS:** We will be using a spiral bound book to record our attendances, so please remember to record your attendance.

**COMMUNITY GRANT**: In January Rhonda lodged a request for a Community Grant with Jenny Ware, the previous federal Member for Hughes. She followed up with the Office of David Moncrieff, the current federal Member for Hughes. David advised that all the applications sent to the department were approved but our application was not included.

**ADRIAN O'MALLEY:** You will remember Adrian O'Malley who was a member and was brought to the show with his friend Martin Davies. Adrian is moving house and is looking for someone to babysit his orchids until accommodation can be settled. It may take a few months. His plants would fill two tables. He is willing to pay for this service. If you can assist Adrian, please let Rhonda know and she will give you his phone number.

**GROWERS GROUP MEETING**: Our next growers group meeting will be held at John Hely's residence on Saturday 25 October. Thank you, John for holding it. It will start at 1pm. # A lovely Species from the August Meeting Dendrochilum cootesii – exhibited by Robert Nicol

The fleshy blooms are unique among Dendrochilums. This really beautiful orchid was named in 1997 after Philippine orchid species expert, lecturer and author - Jim Cootes.

It is extremely beautiful especially the pink form. The most common colour is cream.

Dendrochilum cootesii grows in the Philippines at around 1800 metres on mossy tree trunks on the fringes of cloud forests.

It requires warm, very humid conditions and no frost exposure. Good quality fresh sphagnum moss is suitable - avoid water-logging.


